## I. BACKGROUND

The information in this Addendum is in reference to the income level chart found in Administrative Letter 04-08, Provider Instructions for Determining Presumptive Eligibility, dated March 20, 2008.

Income limits for MPW and Presumptive Eligibility for pregnant woman are revised effective April 1, 2009, to reflect the increase in the federal poverty level.

### D. Monthly Poverty Income Level
